I. Format for Listing the Book

AuthorSurname, AuthorFirstName. *TitleInItalics: Subtitle*. PublisherCity, St: NameofPress, Year. ### pages.

Do not include price, ISBN, a link to a bookseller, or any other extraneous information.

Example:

Brague, Rémi. *Curing Mad Truths: Medieval Wisdom for the Modern Age*. Notre Dame, IN: University of Notre Dame Press, 2019. 142 pages.

II. Length of Review

Please aim for around 850 words. Busy clergy constitute our target audience, so please refrain from longwindedness and esoteric points. Shorter books may have shorter reviews. Particularly impactful books may merit longer reviews. 850 words is not a strict limit, but it tends to be the “sweet spot” for most book reviews.

III. Affiliation

At the end of your review, please state your name along with a short biographical description. This is not a place for your whole life story or a recapitulation of your curriculum vitae. One or two lines suffices to identify you.
